2023's whole school musical week will run from 11 – 14 July 2023. Auditions will take place in January 2023, with rehearsals starting shortly afterwards.

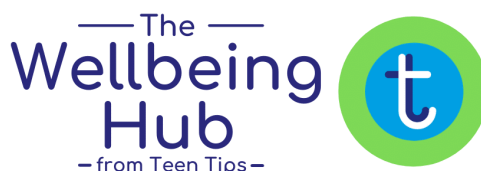

Focus on: Bite Back 2030—School Food Champions

This year, Mrs Hancock has been running an after-school club called Bite Back with students from years 7, 8 & 9. Bite Back is a national, youth led, movement that believes every young person deserves access to healthy, nutritious food, no matter their circumstance. Therefore, our vision was to work with members of staff, students, and the canteen to make healthy, positive change in our school community. Throughout this process the students have been able to learn many new skills and build on their existing experiences and learning. This has resulted in building confidence and self-esteem that will be vital for them moving forward and becoming more rounded individuals inside and outside the classroom.



In February, we welcomed colleagues from Jamie Oliver HQ to George Abbot. We are seen as one of the leading schools in the country undertaking the programme. This was a huge reward for the student's effort, drive, and commitment. They spent the day with us exploring our aims and looking at our food offering - they were blown away with the products on offer and the variety of foods the students could choose from. This collaborative approach led to some of the students at George Abbot becoming faces of their marketing campaign and website. In addition to this the team launched a healthier flapjack (lower fat and sugar) in the canteen which has been hugely successful. Further positive changes in our community will also await them after the summer holidays. Mrs Hancock is extremely proud of all the participating students for their achievements.

The Food & Nutrition team were impressed by the ideas, designs and products produced by each team. 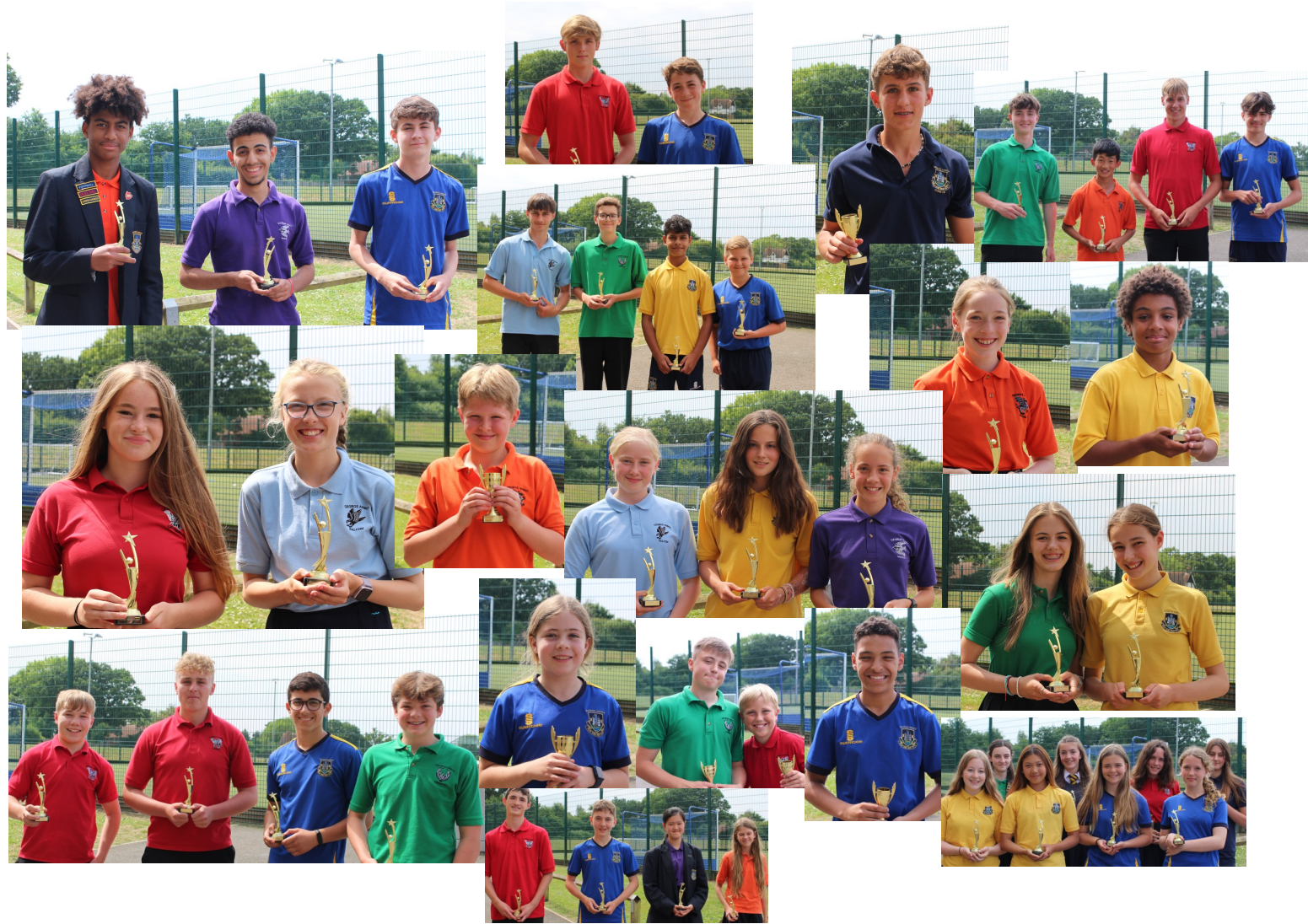
