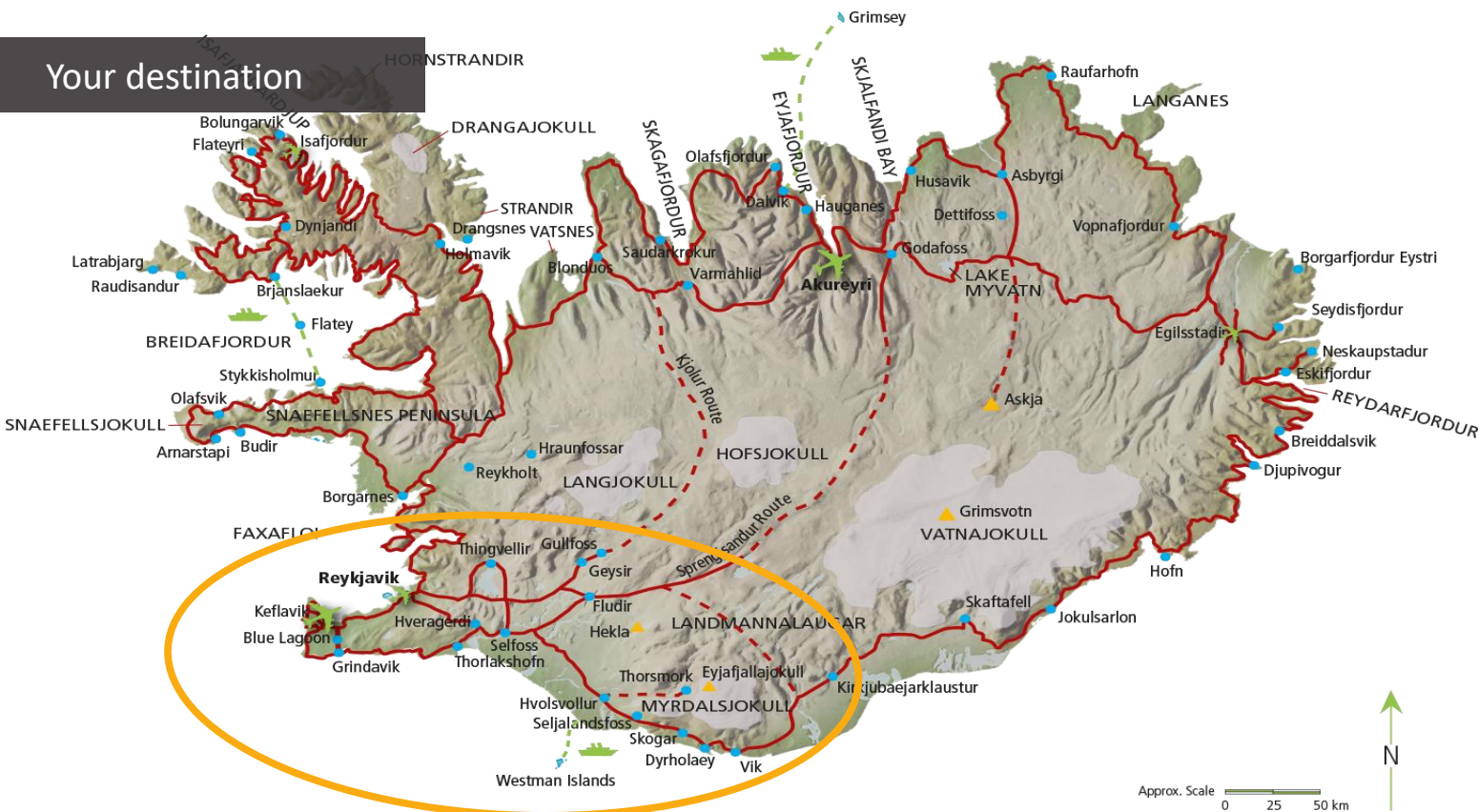

Behind the town of Hveragerði is Reykjadalur, a geothermally active valley. Through this valley flows the Varmá, meaning Warm River. Take a short walk to some hot springs and mud pools.

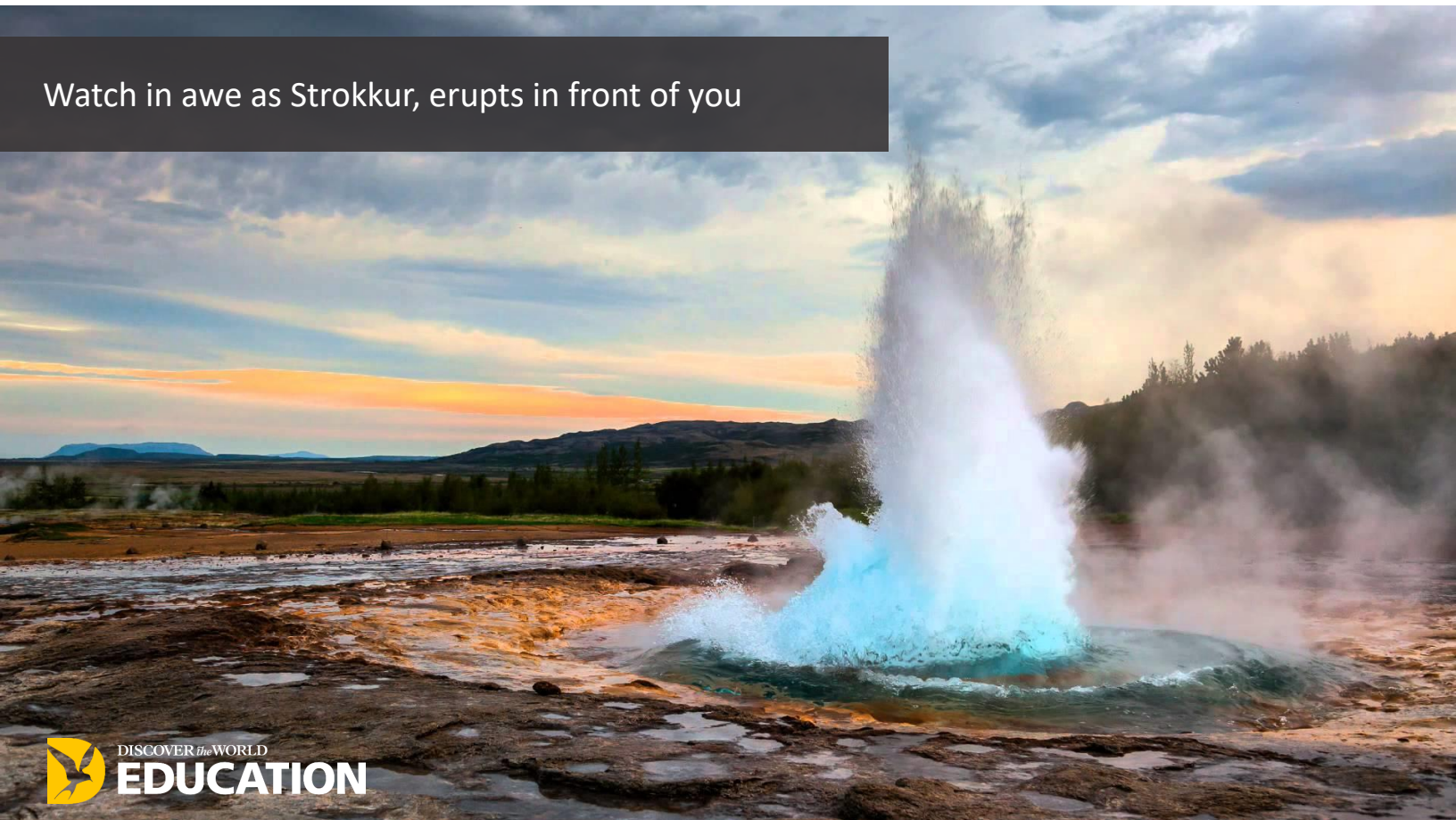


Marvel at Iceland's most photographed waterfall, Gullfoss "Golden Falls"

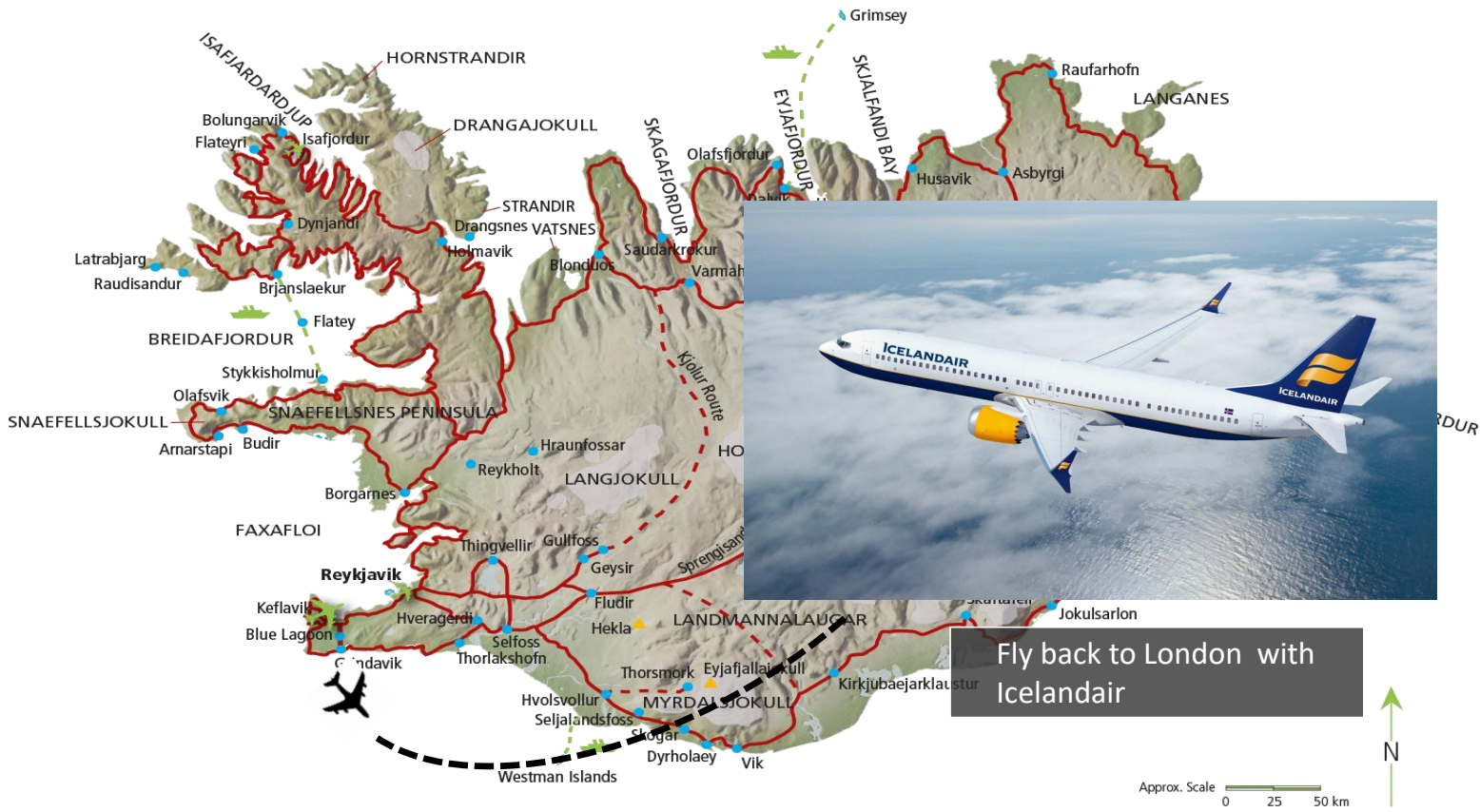

RESPECT PEOPLE

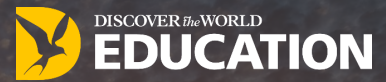
- ✗ Be aware of noise in public places
