
Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are a great way to gain a qualification as well as being paid.

'In essence, an apprenticeship is a job. You'll spend 80% of the working week at your place of employment, and 20% at your place of study. You'll earn a salary, and your course fees will be covered by your employer and the government. You just need to be willing to manage your time between work and study.'

Levels of Apprenticeships

Intermediate Apprenticeship	Advanced Apprenticeship	Higher Apprenticeship	Degree Apprenticeship
Level 2	Level 3	Level 4, 5, 6, 7	Level 6,
12 - 18 months	18 - 48 months	24 months	36 months
Equivalent to 5 GCSEs 9 – 4	Equivalent to A-levels	Equivalent to a foundation degree	Equivalent to a degree



You can apply for an apprenticeship in addition to your five university courses.

You can apply for an apprenticeship after a degree as long as it is in a completely different subject / career to that which you studied at university.
