

Conservatoires

Application processes differ across the different conservatoires, so always make sure to check with the institution directly.

Most applications will be made through UCAS Conservatoires, some through UCAS main scheme, and some will be made directly to the institution.

You can apply for six conservatoires plus five other UCAS courses.

The deadline, for music and composition, tend to be earlier than for universities so make sure to check with the institution.

For these courses you will need two references – one for your music ability and one general subject reference. These are sent separate to your application BUT also need to be upload prior to the deadline which is usually at the very beginning of October, when you are in Y13.
