Praise, Rewards and Sanction

- Students are awarded **House Points** for working hard or contributing positively to the school community.
- House points are celebrated during tutor time and through the Bromcom Student Portal.
- Students can earn **front of queue passes** for the canteen and **individual non-uniform days**.
- Students can be awarded **blazer flashes** for contributions to academia, sports or the arts.
- Students receive **letters home** at the end of term for consistent effort levels at school.
- House points, attendance and effort grades contribute to the **House Cup**.
- Students will be issued with a **behaviour log** for any disruption to the learning of others, or negatively impacting the school community. Three logs in a half term results in a one hour detention after school. Extremely rare for Year7!
