The Sixth-Form team and all at George Abbot have their fingers crossed that you receive the results you deserve and wish for.

On results day, when you go into UCAS Track you will see whether you have been confirmed at your firm choice, firmed at your second choice or not accepted at either and therefore in Clearing.

Alternatively, if you have not achieved the necessary grades, you may have been offered a different, but similar course which may be on a different campus. So, do check!

Clearing is how universities and colleges fill any places they still have on their courses.

Clearing is open from 2 July and closes on 19 October 2026. You can apply for a course using Clearing if you're not already holding an offer from a university or college, and the course still has places.

You can use Clearing if:

- you're applying after 30 June
- you didn't receive any offers (or none you wanted to accept)
- you didn't meet the conditions of your offers
- you've declined your firm place
- you did better than your predicted grades and wish to change your university or course.
